If you give your baby up:

- ◆ No one will know
- ◆ You don't have to give your name
- ◆ You have three days (72 hours) to make this choice
- ◆ You have 14 days if you want your baby back
- ◆ You will not be arrested

The Safe Haven Law allows you to bring your newborn baby up to three days old (72 hours) to a worker at a hospital emergency room, all fire stations displaying safe surrender signs or Orangewood Children's Home.
